Paintings featuring numbers or text break up a salon wall really well. Jack Burton's work feels playful, with numerals seemingly from a child's game of hopscotch incongruously placed over a densely saturated image of a beautiful tree. Jack's print is called a hybrid, in the sense that it begins as a digital print with two colours screenprinted over the top. A varnish overlay over the white beautifully picks up the light and makes the numbers pop out from the background. Kate Bryan, Soho House Head of Collections, says: 'I like Jack Burton's language because it's really peculiar but without ever closing you off - it's a bit surreal but there's a definite open entry, come in, play around with this image.'
